He expected to come back to the committee in the summer with proposals to start a revision programme to enhance it further and make it better embrace the private sector and communications aspects. He further noted that there were 2 comments to the FDIS ballot that were apparently added to the US comments to 14813-6 in error. Since that FDIS ballot has already been successfully concluded and 14813-1 published, these comments are passed on to the 14813-1 revision task force for consideration at the first revision to the Standard.
